Commonly Treated Conditions by Acupuncture and Herbs

Cancer	Liver Cancer, Rectal Cancer, Rhinopharyncarcinoma, Uterine Cancer, Mammary Cancer, Stomach Cancer, Lung Cancer, Brain Tumor, Esophagus Cancer, Leukemia, Malignant Lymphoma, Renocystocarcinoma, Ovary Cancer, Pancreas Cancer Reduce Side Effects of Chemoradiation Therapy or Operation (Nausea, Vomiting, abnormal HGB/WBC/RBC/BPC/GPT/Glob, Fatigue, Palpitation, etc.), Adjust Immune Function, Relieve Pain.
